

ORDINANCE NO. 619-17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AUBREY, TEXAS LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR TAX YEAR 2017 AT THE RATE OF \$0.542049 PER ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS ASSESSED VALUATION OF ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS TO PROVIDED REVENUES FOR CURRENT EXPENSES, INTEREST AND SINKING FUND REQUIREMENTS, AND MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS; PROVIDING DUE AND DELINQUENT DATES, PENALTIES AND INTEREST; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBREY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That there be and is hereby levied for the year 2017 on all taxable property, real, personal and mixed, situated within the corporate limits of the City of Aubrey, Texas and not exempt by the Constitution of the State and valid State laws, a tax of \$0.542049 on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) assessed value of taxable property, which shall be apportioned and distributed as follows:

- (a) For the purpose of defraying the current expenses of the municipal government of the City, and for maintenance and operations of the municipal government of the City, a tax of \$0.212891 on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) assessed value of all taxable property.
- (b) For the purpose of creating a sinking fund to pay the interest and principal on all outstanding bonds or indebtedness of the City, not otherwise provided for, a tax of \$0.329158 on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) assessed value of all taxable property within the City which shall be applied to the payment of such interest and maturates of all outstanding bonds and indebtedness.

SECTION 2. That all ad valorem taxes for the year shall become due and payable on October 1, 2017 and all ad valorem taxes for said year shall become delinquent if not paid before February 1, 2018. There shall be no discount for payment of taxes prior to February 1, 2018. A delinquent tax shall incur a penalty of six percent (6%) of the amount of the tax for the first calendar month it is delinquent plus one percent (1%) for each

additional month or portion of a month the tax remains unpaid prior to July 1, 2018. Provided, however, a tax delinquent on July 1, 2018, shall incur a total penalty of twelve percent (12%) of the amount of the delinquent tax without regard to the number of months the tax has been delinquent. A delinquent tax shall also accrue interest at a rate of one percent (1%) for each month or portion of a month the tax remains unpaid. Taxes that remain delinquent on July 1, 2018, shall incur an additional penalty of twenty percent (20%) or the maximum rate allowed by law, whichever is higher, of the amount of taxes, penalty, and interest due in order to defray costs of collection pursuant to the Property Tax Code.

SECTION 3. Taxes are payable to the Denton County Tax Assessor-Collector. The City shall have available all rights and remedies provided by law for the enforcement of the collection of taxes levied under this ordinance.

SECTION 4. That the tax rolls as presented to the City Council, together with any supplements thereto are hereby approved.


SECTION 5. That all provisions of the Ordinances of the City of Aubrey, Texas in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed, and all other provisions of the Ordinances of the City of Aubrey, Texas not in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. That should any word, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this Ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision hereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional.

SECTION 7. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law and charter in such cases provide.

An Ordinance designating an official paper for the City of Aubrey, Texas, repealing all Ordinances in conflict therewith; providing a term clause; providing a publication clause; providing an effective date.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBREY, TEXAS;

SECTION I
DESIGNATING AN OFFICIAL PAPER OF THE CITY OF AUBREY

Pilot Point Post Signal, published in Denton County, Texas, is hereby designated as the official newspaper of the City of Aubrey, Texas. All legal notices, legal publications, penal ordinances, and other ordinances, required to be published, shall be published in the said Pilot Point Post Signal, unless otherwise specified by the City Council of the City of Aubrey, Texas, in special case, by ordinance. (Sections 52.004 and 52.011 Local Government Code.)

SECTION II
TERM

The term of this Ordinance shall be October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2018.


SECTION III
